Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Had you walked into the Shire Hall last Tuesday, you could have imagined that you were walking into some swanky event in one of our capital cities. For a small school with an active P&F of approximately 20 people, all the accolades received since the event, are truly well deserved. Well done to the P&F and a huge thank you to all those who helped out in any way. I am being stopped in the supermarket, with people commenting on what a great afternoon was had by all. We have even had someone ring and book a table for next year already, as they do not want to miss out.

A reminder that next Monday night (18th) is our last P &F meeting for the year. As well as wrapping up Melbourne Cup, we will be looking at our Christmas raffle and celebrating our achievements for 2014. Everyone is welcome to attend with drinks and nibbles available during the night.

Yesterday, the Prep to Year 2 classes began their "water confidence" classes for the year. In one week the children cannot learn to swim, hence the lessons being 'water confidence' classes. The children are grouped into small groups depending on their ability and then complete a set of activities in order to receive a certificate at the end of the week.
