

APPLE'S LATE founder, Steve Jobs, practised Zen Buddhism, and Google teaches its employees how to meditate, but now it seems that Silicon Valley executives are turning to the Benedictine tradition for advice.

Br David Steindl-Rast, a monk of Mount Saviour Monastery in Pine City, New York, has been invited to address the Wisdom 2.0 Conference in San Francisco, next month. The conference, which features yoga teachers and Zen masters as well as senior executives from Google and

Facebook, focuses on merging wisdom and technology. As well as breakout sessions and workshops, yoga and meditation rooms are offered.

Br David, 87, who was born in Vienna, studied Zen in the 1960s with the permission of his abbot as part of an effort to cultivate Christian-Buddhist dialogue. He is due to speak on gratitude in the digital age and will contribute to a panel on compassionate society. The main theme of the conference is how such skills as mindfulness -maintaining moment-to-moment awareness - can help employees at hi-tech firms.
