<u>Tug-of-War:</u>



Our inaugural Tug-of-War competition was held in 2012. The Mill Team took out the event and it looks like they will again put up at team to defend the title.

Perhaps you might be interested in entering a team. Teams will consist of a maximum of six persons with a maximum total weight of 500kg. Teams can be made up of male and female members. If we get enough interest, we could run a women's division – please speak up. Entry fee is \$100 per team. We had eight teams enter in 2012 – so there are very good odds for taking the winnings away with you.
