LENT IS: A SPECIAL TIME TO REFLECT AND RENEW During Lent Christians make a special effort to look at how we live our lives as disciples of Jesus and try to change the way we live. During Lent we are reminded that we are all tempted to do the wrong thing at times but it is when we give in to the temptation that we forget to follow the example of Jesus and forget to remain faithful to God.

Last Sunday was the FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT. The gospel story from Luke (4:1-13) presents Jesus' struggle to remain true to himself and his faith while in the wilderness. In testing Jesus, Satan is testing God himself and is dismissed from the story with the words – 'You must not put the Lord your God to the test'.


