



It is not surprising that gallons of ink have been spilt by theologians over the centuries reflecting on what Our Lord meant when he used the term "Kingdom of God" and there have been many different views expressed. I think most Catholics if asked would say that it means something like the "Reign of God". In one sense God has always reigned so what did Jesus have in mind when he said in about 30AD "The Kingdom of God is at hand" that is "just around the corner". The Catechism only discusses the term as part of its discussion of the "Our Father". But this is a good starting point. Refer to paras. 2816 to 2821.
